2021 Road Map





SASA TEAM MARINE ANIMALS RESCUE

Sasa Team was initially a group of volunteers teaming up to rescue a dolphin named Sasa who was stuck on the coast of Da Nang in late June 2018. Quickly after the successful rescue, the Sasa team was established. Sasa's work to date includes turtle rescue, ocean clean-ups (from ghost nets) and coral restoration.

With Hoiana's commitment to conservation efforts, protecting wildlife and natural resources, Hoiana is discussing with the Sasa marine team about potential activities which could be a coral restoration day or diving lessons offered to guests (a wonderful opportunity to fundraise for conservation). Hoiana can also support the Sasa team in the transport of the extracted fishing nets for proper disposal or recycling. Hoiana looks forward to supporting the Sasa team in their efforts to protect the environment through meaningful actions.







Projects and Activities

Sustainability framework	With the support from EGL - sustainability partner - Hoiana has built a strong framework that is not only fully aligned with our visions but also reflects the global standards of world's prestige certifications like GSTC and B-Corp.	
Solar X	Sustainable energy: Solar energy is one of the main components Hoiana focus in order to use more and more renewable energy and reduce our reliance on fossil fuels as well as limit greenhouse gas emissions. Therefore, Hoiana has planned to install a solar power system in Q3/2020. At present, all materials and equipment have arrived. Due to the bad weather, however, solar panel installation will be postponed until the end of this year.	
Organic fertilizer production	Compost machine starts operating	
Education and training	At Hoiana, Education and Training for staff is taken seriously. Sustainability Committee is building training framework for Hoianans so that they will get to learn about sustainability in general and its elements, e.g. responsible purchasing, waste management, etc.	

Projects and Activities

BOTTLING PLANT

- Environmental impact of current drinking water consumption: if every guest drinks 2 liters / day = 4 bottles, show the amount at full capacity - with visual support, e.g within 1 week, it would fill a football field, etc.
- ► Hoiana is actively building a truly sustainable drinking water solution at reasonable cost to both guests and employees at Hoiana. A glass bottling plant operated in-house at Hoiana not only eliminates the environmental footprint generated by cross region transportation but also lengthens the lifecycle of glass bottles through refilling multiple times on site.



Initiatives

NEW PROCUREMENT SPACE

- The procurement process is challenging now for F&B with small order purchase, especially some abroad / HCM suppliers send the goods to Danang, not directly to Hoi An. Now they are leaning towards the idea of having their own trucks to pick up at each supplier with 2 types (cold and dry storage). Operating their own warehouse in Danang now doesn't financially make sense to them.
- There hasn't been any statistics about this so the first step is EGL to help with putting up a list of questions so relevant people from Hojana can feed the data to it



OPERATIONAL AREAS:

HOW TO SAVE THE ENERGY CONSUMPTION

Engineering Department has developed operational methods to save the energy, for example setting the operation schedule of water chillers to be "OFF" in peak hours and 3hrs in the night time.

Electricity detailed consumption will be recorded and analyzed every month to timely identify the arising issues.

As a Hoianain, you can also take initiative by following the instructions as follows:


Housekeeping & Front Office

- Supervise the guest room's operation by Room Control Unit. Inform to engineering if abnormal operation such as air conditioning/ lighting for fixing.
- Arrange proper operation schedule for Valet Laundry – Limited using equipment in Peak Hours.

Food & Beverage

- Turn off unnecessary lights after the service time.
- Turn off air conditioning once open door/ window.
- ► Turn off the Kitchen Exhaust Fan repeater unit after service time.





Security

Record the air conditioning/lighting usage in Back Of House Offices, Public Areas and sending reminder to relevant department/ person for better control.

IT

 Setup app for monitoring computer usage and sending reminder to relevant people.

All Departments

- Turn off the light/air conditioning/computer in the office and relevant areas after working hour.
- Priority is given to using electricity during off-peak hours for production reducing electricity costs.

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
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
