
Solar X	Our first fully established sustainability intervention Solar X was connected before the end of the year 2020 and is now producing 3,985 KWH of electricity per day.
	The system has generated 717,305 KWH year to date and is a first stepping stone to a reduced environmental footprint and a wider sustainable energy program.
Sustainable waste management	After detailed planning and budgeting, this project was approved for implementation in Q2 2021. It includes a detailed waste audit and training for all relevant departments as well as the use of the state-of-the-art waste sorting facility in the Podium area and an inclusion of other waste collection points. More details on the waste audit will be mentioned in the next pages.
Responsible consumption	Our consumption behaviors have a significant impact on nature resources and the environment. By switching to using Glassia water, a social enterprise offering a fully circular business model in water bottling, we are reducing a big amount of PET plastic consumption.



WASTE AUDIT

- The first step to sustainable waste management in Hoiana is to understand waste composition and the amount of each waste type in the complex. This understanding will lead to more appropriate, cost-effective, and environmentally friendly approaches to handle waste, as well as better waste management standards and training for Hoiana's personnel.
- ► From 26 May to 9 June, Evegreen Labs our sustainability partner, carried out a comprehensive waste audit in the following waste rooms in Hoiana complex: Golf Course Maintenance (GCM), Golf Club House (GCH), Development Office (DO), Staff Village (HV), and Rosewood/KHOS/Hoiana Hotels & Suites/Hoiana Casino (P2). During audit hours, waste bags were collected and waste separated into three main categories and ten sub-categories:
 - Organics: food waste and green/garden waste
 - Recyclables: mixed paper, cardboard, cartons (i.e. Tetra Pak), rigid plastics, soft plastics, styrofoam, metal, and glass.
 - ▶ Landfill waste

- During the audit, Evegreen Labs also collected information on waste separation, disposal, and removal practices in Hoiana to identify suitable solutions and better procedures.
- Results of the audit have been reported to Hoiana's Sustainability Committee.








HOIANA HOTELS ZERO WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

After a month of preparations and training sessions conducted with 173 associates, we launched the Hoiana Hotels Zero Waste Management Program on May 20, 2021.





GLASSIA WATER

Small things make a big difference. We have placed these stickers on the power switches around the Rosewood executive office to remind everyone to conserve energy as much as they can.



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
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
